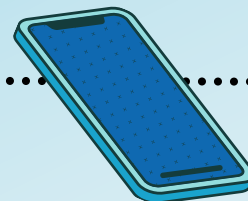

Educators gave the course very high ratings in terms of both usefulness and enjoyment, on a scale from 0=not at all to 4=extremely.

When asked whether they thought the course was “passive and impersonal” or “active and social,” 20 out of 20 educators responded that it felt active and social. More interestingly, when asked what made it feel this way, they listed that they perceived the coaches to be upbeat, supportive, and valuing of their participation. They felt they were constantly doing activities, and that these were hands-on and mixed in terms of their format (e.g. observing, asking questions, etc.)
